
Many successful East Coast Musicians had their start at Summer Rock!

This is a 4 week workshop in which you learn all that is required to produce a full stage rock concert. Under the direction of Sean MacGillivray, a well-respected sound tech in the Metro area, you will have hands-on experience in all aspects of producing quality sound and lighting. You will be involved in all aspects of setting up for Summer Rock, including setting up the stage for each of the daily concerts, the PA's in the classrooms for our rockers, and producing the final concerts of the Junior and Senior camps.
